Comment: In accordance with the provisions of this bill any member of the Armed Forces of the United States, a reserve component thereof or the National Guard, or the spouse, domestic partner or minor child of such persons who wishes to have certain public entities make any records containing their personal information confidential would first have to obtain a court order from a district court requiring the agencies to do so. Under existing Nevada law, certain persons are already authorized to obtain such an order. In Washoe County, each petition for such an order takes an average of 30-45 minutes of staff time of the Second District Judicial Court (SJDC) to review and process. To date, requests for these orders have been able to be absorbed within the existing capacity of the SJDC as only a fraction of those persons entitled to seek an order for confidentiality actually pursue one. If enacted, this bill would likely increase the number of requests received by the SJDC as the number of persons eligible to request such an order would increase significantly. A significant increase in the number of requests would require the addition of one or more new staff positions to accommodate the associated workload. Because the actual number of persons who would choose to seek such an order is unknown, a reliable estimate of the financial effect of this bill on Washoe County cannot be determined.
