The Nevada System of Higher Education has reviewed the proposed legislation and has determined that while there would be a fiscal impact, we are unable to determine the extent of the impact at this time since future projects and their details are unknown. BDR 28-967 would revise provisions governing the circumstances under which a worker is deemed to be employed on a public work. This would extend to workers delivering or removing material, equipment, or structures to or from the site of a public work. NSHE anticipates that there would be a fiscal impact associated with any increase in pay to those drivers working on any related project. Additionally, there would be a bureaucratic cost to contractors who utilize delivery and trucking services to certify payrolls, and those costs would be passed onto the project, resulting in higher project costs.
