The agency has reviewed the bill and has determined there is a fiscal impact. Section 2(g) allows for the Victims of Crime compensation officer to reimburse the cost associated with conducting a strangulation forensic medical investigation of a victim of domestic violence battery by strangulation that was paid by the county under Section 1 of this bill. The agency anticipates that could be approximately 120 examinations statewide per month with an estimated cost of \$1,500 per exam.
