AB356 / BDR 15-1007 is an act relating to mobile tracking devices; prohibiting a person from installing, concealing, or otherwise placing a mobile tracking device in or on the motor vehicle of another person under certain circumstances; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1 provides that a person shall not install a mobile tracking device on a motor vehicle without the knowledge and consent of an owner or lessor of the vehicle. If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 6 NOCs and 6 subtypes. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
