AB332 / BDR 55-162 is an act relating to student education loans; providing for the licensing and regulation of student loan servicers; providing for the regulation of private education loans; requiring the Commissioner to adopt certain regulations; authorizing the Commissioner to engage in certain activities; establishing certain duties and prohibitions; providing a penalty and other matters.

If this bill is enacted as introduced, the proposed bill may impact RCCD with an unknown increase in workload to the Fingerprint Support Unit and the Fingerprint Examiner Unit. RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing. The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) will need to review and approve the language of the bill to determine whether or not it meets the criteria pursuant to Public Law 92-544 as a condition of releasing its criminal history records. RCCD will coordinate the review by the FBI. If the language does not meet the criteria, RCCD will advise and coordinate with the sponsor and/or respective agency to amend the bill to include the appropriate language. If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 1 NOC and 1 subtype. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
