The agency has reviewed this bill and has determined that there will be a fiscal impact upon the Nevada Board of Osteopathic Medicine ("the Board"). The bill expands the scope of the current licensure provisions for physician assistants licensed pursuant to NRS Chapter 633 thus necessitating changes to the Board's proprietary licensing system. This would require the customization by its licensing system vendor at an estimated cost of \$2,000. The bill also requires development of appropriate regulations costing the Board an estimated \$5,000 for contract Board Counsel time to draft new and/or revised regulations, conduct workshops and prepare final proposed regulations. Miscellaneous cost estimates are \$1,500. As it would be difficult to determine exactly how much of the above expenses would be incurred in FY2022-23 and FY2023-24, those costs will be equally divided between those two fiscal years. As there would not appear to be any changes to the licensing/renewal fees pertaining to Physician Assistants licensed pursuant to NRS Chapter 633, there would be no new or additional licensing revenue as a result of these changes.
