BDR 20-666 (SB 83) relates to confidential information and would authorize a civilian employee that provides support services to a law enforcement agency to (1) obtain certain court orders, and (2) make requests to the Department to display an alternate address on a person's driver's license or ID card in certain circumstances. This bill becomes effective on October 1 2023.

The Department has reviewed this bill and determined it will have no fiscal impact. DMV already has procedures in place for requesting display of alternate addresses and this bill's provisions would be incorporated into that existing process.
