AB364 / BDR 54-148 is an act relating to physician assistants; prescribing the settings in which a physician assistant is authorized to practice; authorizing physician assistants to perform medical services; authorizing certain unlicensed persons to use the title "inactive physician assistant"; removing the requirement that a rural clinic be supervised; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 17 provides for renumbering of NRS 630.400. Section 32 provides for renumbering of NRS 633.741.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to modify 8 NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
