SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the sale of real property. (BDR 10-1005)

AN ACT relating to real property; requiring a seller of real property that includes a private well to

disclose to the buyer the quality of and amount of certain chemicals in the water in the

private well; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law sets forth certain disclosures that a seller of real property is required to make to a

purchaser in a real estate transaction. (NRS 113.060-113.150) This bill requires a seller of real

property that contains a private well to disclose to the purchaser the results of a test concerning the

quality of the water in the private well. This bill further requires that: (1) the disclosure indicate

whether the water in the private well complies with certain standards of water quality and the

amounts of certain chemicals in the water; (2) the test be performed within 90 days before the date

of closing; and (3) the test be conducted by a laboratory with a certain certification.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 113 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. Before the date of closing in a real estate transaction, a seller of real property that includes a private well shall disclose, in writing, to the purchaser the results of a test which concerns the quality of the water in the private well. The results of the test must indicate:
- (a) Whether the water in the private well complies with the standards of water quality established by the State Environmental Commission pursuant to NRS 445A.425; and
 - (b) The amounts of arsenic, cadmium, lead, mercury and zinc in the water.
 - 2. The test must be conducted:
 - (a) Within 90 days before the date of closing; and
- (b) By a laboratory certified in accordance with the regulations adopted pursuant to NRS 445A.425 and 445A.428.
 - 3. As used in this section:
- (a) "Private well" means a well that is not a public water system or part of a public water system.
 - (b) "Public water system" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 445A.235.
