AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Department of Agriculture for the purpose of awarding grants of money to Nevada school districts to provide universal free breakfast and lunch for Nevada pupils; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for the purpose  
3 of awarding grants of money to Nevada school districts to provide  
4 universal free breakfast and lunch to Nevada pupils the following  
5 sums:

6 For the Fiscal Year 2025-2026..... \$43,000,000  
7 For the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 ..... \$43,000,000

8 2. Any balance of the sums appropriated by subsection 1  
9 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be  
10 committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal  
11 years by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity  
12 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise  
13 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated  
14 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after  
15 September 18, 2026, and September 17, 2027, respectively, by



1 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity  
2 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and  
3 must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
4 September 18, 2026, and September 17, 2027, respectively.

5 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2025.
