The Nevada Department of Corrections has reviewed SB 100. Section 1 of this bill requires a public officer whose duty is imposed under provisions governing the election laws to notify the Secretary of State and the Attorney General if he or she will not be able to perform that duty. Section 1 further provides information on how those duties would be performed should a public officer be removed or is unable to perform their duties. Section 2 prescribes that a public officer who is charged with duties relating to an election who fails to perform their duties is guilty of a category E felony. Section 3 relates to vendors for voting systems. After reviewing admissions data from 2022 to 2024, there were no sentences found under NRS 293.800. Additionally, the felony prescribed in this bill (category E) includes probation as a punishment. The department does not believe that this bill would have any significant impact on offender population levels and no fiscal impact on the department as written.
