The Nevada Department of Corrections has reviewed SB 110. This bill increases the minimum and maximum terms of imprisonment for a person found guilty of facilitating sex trafficking. To help determine the potential impact of this bill, the department reviewed sentencing data for offenders housed, admitted, and released between 2021 and 2024 and found that there were no offenders that were incarcerated under the applicable NRS (NRS 201.301). The department does not expect that this bill would have any significant impact on the offender population levels and estimates no potential fiscal impact on the department at this time.
