If enacted, the proposed regulation would require the Department to develop and update a list of all states with equivalent requirements and qualifications for licensure; permit simultaneous enrollment in multiple ARL programs; waive licensure fees for substitutes transitioning to a standard license; and the development of 1-year provisional licenses. Pursuant to Sec 1., NDE has identified the need for approximately \$62,500 to develop existing licensure software to support 1-year provisional licenses, and costs for 0.50 FTE EPP to support the development of the list of state with equivalent requirements. Sec. 3 waives fees equivalent to \$200 per applicant, requiring general funds to support the necessary background checks; in year 1, there is an estimated financial impact of \$400,000, and in year 2 and subsequent years, \$200,000.
