SB 113 (BDR 43-660) relates to motor vehicles and would additionally authorize occupational therapist or physical therapist to certify a person's disability relating to an application for a special or temporary parking placard or special license plate. This bill would become effective on October 1, 2025.

The Department has reviewed this bill and determined there is no impact as written. Adding the authority of occupational therapist or physical therapist into DMV's existing policies/ procedures as well as applicable forms would be absorbed and integrated in the existing operations.
