BDR 15-64 / AB105 AN ACT relating to firearms; prohibiting, under certain circumstances, the possession of a firearm in or within a certain distance of an election site.

Section 1 of this bill prohibits a person from possessing or cause a firearm to be present in, or within 100 feet of an entrance to, a place the person knows or reasonably should know is an election site. Section 3 of this bill prohibits a person from possessing a firearm or cause a firearm to be present at an election site with the specific intent to disrupt, interfere with or monitor the administration of the election, the counting of votes or any person who is voting or attempting to vote.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records, Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 4 NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2025 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2025-2027 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
