BDR 15-174 / SB89 AN ACT relating to crimes; prohibiting the purchase, possession or ownership of a firearm by a person who has been convicted of committing or attempting to commit a crime motivated by certain characteristics of the victim; and other matters.

Section 1 of this bill prohibits a person from purchasing, owning or having in his or her possession or under his or her custody or control any firearm if the person has been convicted within the immediately preceding 10 years of committing or attempting to commit certain offenses. Section 1 also prohibits a person from purchasing, owning or having in his or her possession or under his or her custody or control any firearm if the person has been convicted of committing or attempting to commit certain offenses involving violence that are motivated by certain characteristics of the victim. Section 2 of this bill makes a conforming change to provide that, for purposes of prosecuting a violation of section 1, each firearm purchased by a person constitutes a separate violation.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to modify 11 NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2025 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2025-2027 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
