BDR 15-342 / SB60 AN ACT relating to crimes; expanding the types of crimes that require an additional penalty for certain crimes committed against older or a vulnerable person; increasing the penalties for residential burglary and invasion of the home when those crimes are committed against an older person; providing penalties; and other matters.

Section 2 of this bill increases the minimum term of imprisonment to not less than 2 years and the maximum term of imprisonment to not more than 20 years if a person: (1) is convicted of residential burglary; and (2) causes the death of or serious bodily injury to a person 60 years of age or older during the commission of the crime.

Section 3 of this bill increases the minimum term of imprisonment to not less than 2 years and the maximum term of imprisonment to not more than 20 years if a person: (1) is convicted of invasion of the home; and (2) causes the death of or serious bodily injury to a person 60 years of age or older during the commission of the crime.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records, Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 4 sub-types and 4 NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2025 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2025-2027 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
