SB102 / BDR 24-90 AN ACT relating to elections; prohibiting a person from, with intent to defraud, knowingly creating, filing or otherwise submitting certain documents relating to elections; prohibiting a person from creating or serving in a false slate of presidential electors or conspiring to create or serve in a false slate of presidential electors; prohibiting the State or a local government from appointing to public office a person convicted of such an offense; prohibiting a person from interfering with the selection of presidential electors; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1 of this bill prohibits a person from not, with intent to defraud, knowingly create, file or otherwise submit pursuant to the provisions of this title any false document or document which contains false signatures. Section 3 of this bill prohibits from a person from creating or serving in a false slate of presidential electors or conspiring to create or serve in a false slate of presidential electors.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records, Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 6 NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2025 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2025-2027 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
