BDR 15-57 (SB110) is related to sex trafficking and increases the penalties for the commission of the crime of facilitating sex trafficking. The bill becomes effective October 1, 2025.

The agency has reviewed the bill and determined that increased sentences will result in longer prison and/or supervision terms. Longer terms could result in an increased number of supervision officers required by the division. The Division does not possess the necessary data to estimate how these longer sentences will affect supervision numbers and whether a change could be absorbed by existing staff or would require additional staff. Therefore, the total impact of this bill cannot be determined at this time. The agency reserves the right to go to the Interim Finance Committee for the future biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
