Senate Bill 81 (BDR 34-276) makes various changes relating to education. It would require the Department of Education (DOE) to create and conduct surveys of public school employees; revise provisions governing transfer of funds to the Stabilization Account; revise certain provisions relating to service delivery to students and reporting and general administration. The bill would become effective on July 1, 2025.

The Department has reviewed this bill and determined there is no projected fiscal impact; DMV is not involved with Education surveys or general administration of the DOE.
