This legislation would create the Legislative Committee on the Reduction of Nonessential State Expenditures (Committee) as a statutory interim committee. The legislation specifies that the Committee would consist of six members and that for each day or portion of a day during which a member of the Committee attends a meeting of the Committee or is otherwise engaged in the business of the Committee, the member is entitled to receive the: (a) Compensation provided for a majority of the members of the Legislature during the first 60 days of the preceding regular session; (b) Per diem allowance provided for state officers and employees generally; and (c) Travel expenses provided pursuant to NRS 218A.655.5. The legislation also specifies that all such compensation, per diem allowances and travel expenses must be paid from the Legislative Fund.

This legislation would have a fiscal impact on the Legislative Counsel Bureau. However, the amount of the fiscal impact cannot be determined, as this legislation does not specify the exact number of meetings that would occur. In addition, both the location of the meetings and the specific members of the committee itself are not known. Therefore, an estimate of travel costs is not possible.
