The Nevada Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR 15-776 relating to the unlawful dissemination of intimate images. Section 1 of this bill expands the definition of "intimate images". Section 2 of the bill additionally relates to the intent to harass, harm or terrorize another person. Section 3 of this bill expands the list of sexual offenses to apply to this crime.

While attempting to measure the potential impact of this bill, the department reviewed data for offenders between 2022-2024 and found that no offenders were sentenced under NRS 200.770 or NRS 200.780. While the expanded provisions in this bill will likely increase the possible number of offenses, there have been no incarcerations with NDOC for these offense in recent years.

The department does not anticipate this bill to have any significant impact on population levels. The NDOC does not anticipate a fiscal impact at this time.
