Assembly Bill 150 (BDR 15-157) relates to tribal judges and makes various prohibitions relating to threatening behavior and intimidating actions against tribal judges of certain federally recognized Native American tribes, and authorizes such a judge to request the DMV to display an alternate address on the driver's license or ID card of the judge. The bill becomes effective on October 1, 2025.

The Department has reviewed this bill and determined there is no impact as written. DMV already has procedures in place for requesting display of alternate addresses and this bill's provisions would be incorporated into that existing process.
