If enacted, the proposed legislation would require that students enrolled in a program of career and technical education must take a licensure test to pass the class. Sec. 1 requires the Department to develop guidelines, ensure costs are paid by boards of trustees, facilitate scheduling and administration of these exams at school facilities, and coordinate with licensing boards to develop model payment plans. The Department had identified a fiscal impact requiring 1 FTE MAIL.
