Per section 1, this bill revises the amount of the tax on live entertainment that is required to be distributed to the Nevada Arts Council. This bill will not have a fiscal impact to the Department of Taxation as it has been determined that additional resources will not be required to implement the bill. However, the bill will decrease the general fund portion of the live entertainment non-gaming revenue by \$916,990 in FY26 and \$932,560 in FY27. The Nevada Arts Council will receive the \$1.85 million as additional revenue in the biennium. The effect on future biennia cannot be determined as the Live Entertainment forecast revenue for future years beyond FY27 has not been determined by the Economic Forum.
