Senate Bill 181 (BDR 43-787) relates to education and among the key provisions directs the Department to design, prepare and issue a new special plate indicating support for Nevada State University (NSU). The Department is authorized to charge \$35 for issuance and \$10 for renewals, in addition to all other applicable license, registration and governmental services taxes (GST). Additional fees generated from this plate, \$25 for original issuance and \$20 for renewal, are to be deposited with the State Treasurer for distribution to NSU on a quarterly basis. This plate type will be exempt from the existing special plate stipulations regarding approval by the DMV, total number of plates that must be issued and total number of special plate designs issued. The bill becomes effective on July 1, 2025.

The Department has reviewed this bill and estimated that the impact cannot be determined as currently written. DMV is currently engaged in its "transformation effort" (DTE), to revise business processes, reorganize, and move systems to a cloud solution. This will greatly improve DMV services and allow more customer transactions online. DTE is focused on vehicle products and services through FY 26/27. The proposed effective date will require programing, testing and implementation in the legacy system and DTE with a combined total of approximately 188 hours. DMV will utilize inhouse programming staff to make these changes in the legacy system while contracted staff incorporate the DTE changes.
