The Nevada Board of Psychological Examiners (Board) has no information as to the projected number of those who would be licensed under the new Behavioral Health and Wellness Practitioner (BHWP) designation, either initially or over time. To that end, it is unable to project the revenue that SB165 would provide to the Board based upon the maximum \$200 licensing/triennial renewal fees the bill provides. Without a better understanding of what will be required to accommodate the new BHWP licensure designation within the Board, and without any information as to the projected number of those who would be licensed under the new BHWP designation and whether a maximum of \$200 for licensure/triennial renewal fees would cover what is required for that licensee designation, the extent of the fiscal impact to the Board regarding expenses is unknown.
