BDR 15-591 (AB187) is expanding certain prohibitions relating to pornography involving minors (artificial intelligence generated minor or altered images). The bill becomes effective on July 1, 2025.

The agency has reviewed the bill and determined that as the bill expands prohibited material, any arrest and subsequent convictions involving the new prohibited material would require additional pre-sentence investigation staff and supervision officers. The division does not possess the necessary data to estimate a number of convictions to determine whether the increase could be absorbed by existing staff or would require additional staff. Therefore, the total impact of this bill cannot be determined at this time. The agency reserves the right to go to the Interim Finance Committee for the future biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
