Comment: SB103 proposes amendments to the current regulations governing the deadlines and criteria for the acceptance of mail-in ballots. The bill stipulates that, for a mail ballot to be counted, it must bear either a United States Postal Service postmark or a date stamp from the county clerk. Furthermore, the legislation would alter the deadlines by which mail ballots must be received by the Elections Department to be considered valid. According to the Elections Department, the necessary updates to equipment and systems resulting from this proposed change are estimated to incur costs of approximately \$3,850,000.
