Comment: This bill safeguards nonprofit donor privacy by prohibiting government entities from requiring or disclosing donor, member, or volunteer information, as outlined in Section 2. It also establishes penalties for unauthorized disclosures and grants individuals the right to sue for damages under Section 2(4). However, there are exceptions for compliance with federal law, court orders, and criminal investigations. Most of the information the City receives would likely fall under one or more of these exceptions. Verifying on a case-by-case basis whether certain information qualifies as an exception would require additional staff time for public records requests. If staff misclassifies information, the City could face lawsuits. Ultimately, this bill could expose the City to increased liability, including monetary damages, attorney's fees, and other costs. However, given that there are several unknowns a cost estimate cannot be determined at this time.
