Comment: This bill could have a fiscal impact on the school district by increasing its financial obligations for retiree health benefits. By extending eligibility for state retiree health subsidies to employees hired on or after January 1, 2012, the district may face higher long-term costs related to funding these benefits. Additionally, removing restrictions on reinstating coverage could lead to more retirees re-enrolling in the plan, further increasing the district's share of contributions. If the bill results in greater participation in the Public Employees' Benefits Program, the district may need to allocate additional funds to cover these expenses but the impact cannot be determined.
