AB93 (BDR 53-160) amends NRS 617.135 to expand the definition of "police officer" to include all category I peace officers. Additionally, the bill provides that the use of designations by the Department of Public Safety to identify itself does not exclude from the definition of "police officer" any person employed by the Department of Public Safety who is included in the definition of "police officer" under existing law. As introduced, this bill would have a fiscal impact on the Nevada Department of Public Safety. The proposed legislation would require the department to provide for the cost of annual physicals for the Chief of the Parole and Probation division and all police officers in the Capitol Police division, as these positions are not currently listed in the statute and therefore not included in the respective division's budgetary requests. The projected cost would be \$44,793 annually. The amount for fiscal year 2026 reflects projected costs for six months, as the proposed legislation becomes effective on January 1, 2026, if passed.
