## **Explanation**

DETR has reviewed BDR 18-83 / SB107 and determined there is a fiscal impact related to an increased caseload for investigations by the Nevada Equal Right Commission. It is projected the agency would require the hiring of two Compliance Investigators II to handle the increased caseload in housing cases (Sections 32 and 33). Likewise, the requirements of Sections 12, 15, and 19 would necessitate the hiring of two more Compliance Investigators II to address the increased caseload in employment and public accommodation discrimination cases. The increased caseloads would also necessitate the hiring of two more Administrative Assistants II as support staff for the additional investigators.

The additional staff required to accommodate this bill would require leasing a larger space in Las Vegas. The current location would not facilitate any additional staff and a different location would need to be secured.

In addition to the identified increased expenses, DETR believes a full-time DAG would need to be devoted to NERC in order to accommodate the increased caseload. This expense is difficult to precisely identify, but needs to be considered in looking at the overall picture.
