Press Accreditation Information

83rd (2025) Legislative Session

Welcome members of the press to the 83rd (2025) Legislative Session. This page provides relevant information related to the press accreditation process. If you are a member of the press, such as a reporter, a journalist, or a camera operator for a news media outlet, and you plan to use press space in the Senate or Assembly chambers, you must follow the press accreditation steps that are outlined on this informational page.

The first step in the press accreditation process is to complete the press accreditation request form, which can be found at: https://www.leg.state.nv.us/Lobbyist/83rd2025/Press. Once you submit the press accreditation form, the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB) will verify the information contained in the submitted request.

As part of the verification process, you will be required to submit a copy of: (1) your driver's license or other photo identification to confirm your identity; and (2) your press credentials as proof that you represent the news media outlet for which you sought accreditation. If proper identification is not presented during the verification process, the LCB will reach out to the Nevada Press Association or Nevada Broadcasters Association to verify the information that is contained in your press accreditation request form.

After submitting your press accreditation request form, you should report to the Legislative Building in Carson City or the Nevada Legislature Office Building in Las Vegas to take a photograph for your press badge. The Legislative Building is located at 401 South Carson Street, Carson City, Nevada 89701. At this location, you may have your photograph taken Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. The Nevada Legislature Office Building is located at 7230 Amigo Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119. At this location, you may have your photograph taken Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Once you have taken your photograph for your press badge and your press accreditation form has been verified by the LCB, your press badge will be available for pickup at the Lobbyist Registrar's office in Room 1199 of the Legislative Building in Carson City. The press badge can be picked up Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Once you obtain your press badge, your name will be sent to the Senate and Assembly for purposes of reading your name into the record. You will not be considered accredited until your name is read into the record of each house.
